Prior to the year A. D. 1865 the Jewish style, namely, the year of the world, was used by Red Men in dating their documents. At the Council held in G. S. 5926 this system was discontinued, and G. D. S., or Great Sun of Discovery, was adopted, the year 1492 being considered G. S. D. 1. For convenience it was determined that the Great Sun should commence on the first Cold Moon, so as to conform to the common era.
