Our seals are all fitted on strong, durable lever presses and will give entire satisfaction. The presses are japanned and ornamented in gold bronze and colors. The handles have nickel plated tops. We use oil tempered springs of great strength, which very much improve the action and life of the press.

It is very important that you give the exact matter you wish on the seal. Your seal, to be legal, must contain the name, number and location of Council and date of institution. Be sure to give this correctly. Write the matter very plainly. The life of our seals is almost unlimited.

- 24DP—Seal, size of plate 1 3/4 inches, with name, number, location of Council, date of institution and letters D. of P.
- 25DP—Seal, 2-inch plate, with name, number and location of Council, date of institution and D. of P. emblem. The emblematic feature makes this seal especially attractive.

Ritual Cases

- 26DP—Ritual Case, of extra heavy tin, japanned and ornamented in bronze, handle on top recessed into cover. This case is very durably made, having best three-tumbler lock and two flat keys. Size 10 7/8 x 7 3/8 x 4 1/4 inches outside.
- 27DP—Ritual Case, similar in construction to 26DP, size of this case being 10 7/8 x 7 3/8 x 5 1/4 inches.
- 28DP—Ritual Case, having the Acme Dial Combination Lock, the best manufactured. The combination can be changed an unlimited number of times. Body of extra heavy tin, handsomely finished. Nickel plated dial, outside measurements 10 7/8 x 7 3/8 x 4 1/4 inches. We call special at-

attention to the ritual cases with combination locks, inasmuch as there are no keys to lose. It happens often that the officer in charge will lose or forget the key to the ritual case, and thus delay the meeting. The trouble is entirely eliminated with the use of combination lock.

Special cold blast Tubular Square Lantern, made of very best heavy sheet tin, satisfactory for either oil or electricity, wind-proof, perfect combustion, no smoke when oil is used. ### Information You Must Furnish

If you order a lantern with electric lamp you must give the voltage of your lighting system. Also, whether the current is alternating or direct. This information is absolutely necessary.

These lanterns are for display on the outside or exterior of the building wherein the Council is meeting. Their object is to show the meeting place, to serve as a beacon to a visiting member in your vicinity, and to remind your own members that Council is to be held on the night they see it lighted. This feature more than repays the investment.

Our frosted glass slides have a feature that can not be supplied in the ordinary hall lantern where plain glass slides are used. Prior to the year A. D. 1865 the Jewish style, namely, the year of the world, was used by Red Men in dating their documents. At the Council held in G. S. 5926 this system was discontinued, and G. D.
